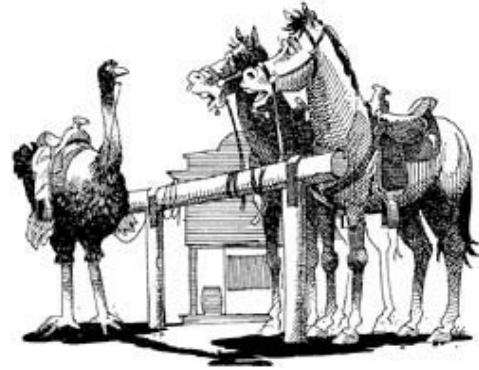

NSWRHA Eligibility and High Points

Eligibility for all competition for 2009/2010 will be based on the 2009 Reining Australia Eligibility List.

The NSWRHA High Point System will be based on the following rules.

Points for 1st = Number of horses in class (Maximum of 10 points)

Points for 2nd = Number of horses in class—1

Points for 3rd = Number of horses in class—2

The NSWRHA member with the highest NSWRHA High Point (must have 20 or more points) and has competed in 65% of shows during the season will win the NSWRHA High Point award.

(In the event of a tie the person who has attended the most shows during the season will win the High Point award).

2009-2010 Club Rules and Regulations

NSWRHA High Points

- ☐ To be eligible for High Points you must be a full financial member.
- ☐ NSWRHA High Points will only commence accumulating from the time membership is received.
- ☐ NSWRHA High Points will not be retrospectively earned for runs at shows prior to membership dues being paid for the season.
- ☐ NSWRHA High Points are calculated by using the NRHA Youth high point scale in the NRHA Rulebook. The winner of the class will be awarded the number of points equivalent to the number of horses entered and run in the class. Second place will be awarded the next descending number and so on. The maximum number of points awarded is 10 for a winner of an event, regardless of the number of horses in the event.
- ☐ Zero scores will not be awarded NSWRHA High Points but will go towards the number of horses entered in an event.
- ☐ Scratched horses will not count towards the number of horses in a class for the purpose of NSWRHA High Points.
- ☐ Riders tying in a class will be awarded average points between those placing.
- ☐ NSWRHA High Point awards will be awarded to the winner and the runner up of each class providing they have shown in at least 65% of shows for the season. If a winner or runner up has not met the 65% requirement they will receive a certificate only for their award.
- ☐ NSWRHA High Point Buckles will be awarded on the following Non Pro and Open classes:
- ☐ Novice Horse, Youth, Ladies, OF50, Rookie, Limited, Intermediate, Open, Snaffle Bit/Hackamore, 2 Handed Rookie, and Beginner on the provision that the High Point Conditions have been met.

Showing Rules

- ☐ Eligibility will be based on the current Reining Australia Eligibility List
- ☐ Ribbon Days do not pay out prize money on any classes and approval has not been sought from Reining Australia.
- ☐ Each rider agrees to allow themselves to be photographed and/or videoed for judging purposes. In addition, each rider agrees to be photographed and/or videoed for marketing purposes unless written notice has been received by the committee.
- ☐ The committee reserves the right to determine if a scratched entry will receive a refund. Each case will be determined on its own merit.
- ☐ **A rider must OWN the horse they are riding in order to compete in a Non Pro event (as per the NRHA Rulebook). These events include all Non-Pro events (including Rookies) and Youth. (Horses may be owned by immediately family member of rider.)**
- ☐ All classes are subject to NRHA rules regarding Equipment and Attire with the exception that Beginners and Green Riders do not require a western saddle.

NSW Non Pro Conditions

- ☐ Any Non Pro is not able to receive remuneration directly or indirectly for giving lessons, training horses, riding astride. Any failure to observe this rule will result in immediate disqualification from NSWRHA Non Pro classes. The committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel a Non Pro entry at any time.
- ☐ Any rider who has previously not met the requirements of Non Pro status must meet all Non Pro conditions for a period of at least 2 years.
- ☐ Our members have the right to protest a Non Pro's eligibility. To do this it must be lodged in writing to the committee with a \$50 fee. If the protest is upheld the \$50 fee will be refunded.
- ☐ Any change of Non Pro status must be notified in writing to the committee within 30 days.
- ☐ **A rider must OWN the horse they are riding in order to compete in a Non Pro event (as per the NRHA Rulebook). These events include all Non-Pro events (including Rookies) and Youth. (Horses may be owned by immediately family member of rider.)**

Class Conditions

NSW Beginner

1. Riders must be a Non Pro.
2. A Beginner can only ride in this class for one season, or part thereof. After such time they will be ineligible.
3. If a Beginner competes in any other event and wins they are no longer eligible, with the exception of Green Rider and Any Handed classes.
4. Beginners are able to use an approved snaffle bit, bosal/hackamore or bridle, regardless of the age of the horse. A Beginner must ride in a western saddle.
5. A Beginner does not need to own the horse they are riding.

NSW Green Rider

1. Riders must be a Non Pro.
2. A Green Rider can only ride in this class for one season, or part thereof. After such time they will be ineligible.
3. Each rider may only obtain 2 wins. At that point they are no longer eligible for this class.
4. The NSW green rider will ride to pattern 6a, which does not require a lead change.
5. This class may be ridden with one hand or two hands, and may change between one or two hands during this run, without being subject to penalty or a "zero" score for the reason.
6. A green Rider may have a "caller" assisting them with the order of the manoeuvres of a pattern.
7. There will be no High Points for Green rider.
8. A Green Rider does not need to own the horse they are riding.

NSWRHA 2 Handed Rookie

1. Riders must be a Non Pro.
2. You must be eligible for this class as per the NRHA rulebook and the 2009 Reining Australia Eligibility List. That is, a rider must not have earned more than \$200 lifetime NRHA earnings **or if they have previously won a NSWRHA High Point in this event.**
3. Entrants must be a Non Pro.
4. Each rider may only obtain 8 wins. At the point they are no longer eligible for this class.
5. Any horse is eligible to be ridden in 2 Handed Rookie class. Horses do not have to be novice horses.
6. 2 Handed Rookies can ride one or two handed but cannot change hands once they enter the pen.
7. In this class you may use an approved snaffle bit, bosal/hackamore or bridle, however the use of equipment/bits is governed by the age of the horse, as per NRHA rules.
8. This class is subject to the equipment and attire requirements of the NRHA rulebook.
9. A 2-Handed Rookie must adhere to the horse ownership rules referred to above.

NSWRHA Rookie

1. Riders must be a Non Pro.
2. You must be eligible for this class as per the NRHA rulebook and the 2009 Reining Australia Eligibility Lists. That is, a rider must not have earned more than \$200 lifetime NRHA earnings **or if they have previously won a NSWRHA High Point in this event.**
3. Riders must ride one handed.
4. All other NRHA rules apply with the exception of licensing and membership rules.
5. A Rookie must adhere to the horse ownership rules referred to above.

NSWRHA Any Handed

1. This event is open to all Open and Non Pro riders and horse.
2. Riders may use an approved snaffle bit, bosal/hackamore or bridle, regardless of the age of the horse.
3. This class may be ridden with one hand or two hands, and may change between one or two hands during this run, without being subject to penalty or a "zero" score for that reason.
4. An Any-Handed competitor does not need to own the horse they are riding.

NSWRHA Ladies

1. Any female rider is eligible for this class
2. Any horse is eligible to be ridden in this class.
3. Open and Non Pro riders may compete in this class.
4. Horses over 5 must be ridden one handed in a bridle and horses under five may be ridden in an approved snaffle bit, bosal or hackamore.
5. A Ladies competitor does not need to own the horse they are riding.

Release and Waiver of Liability

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities, I, _____ (PARTICIPANT'S NAME), the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

- 1 Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.
- 2 There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this lesson.
- 3 I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the proprietors of NSW REINING HORSE ASSOCIATION (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and **I voluntarily PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.
- 4 I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this lesson.
- 5 I agree to follow the directions of the coach and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction can result in the **CANCELLATION** of participation in the activity and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.
- 6 I understand that NSW Reining Horse Association recommends that a hard hat should be worn at all times whilst riding and take sole responsibility for my actions if I choose not to wear a hard hat.
- 7 I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, **HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AND AGREE NOT TO SUE** the proprietors of NSW REINING HORSE ASSOCIATION , their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") **WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, OR loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.**
